Potential topics might include, but are not limited to, tax competition and coordination, intergovernmental grants and transfer systems, interjurisdictional mobility, municipal mergers, education policy, zoning and regulations, bidding for firms, the effect of the digitalization, telework, and the pandemic on subnational governments, subnational business taxation, political economy, local austerity programs, and urban policy.
